



T122, T124, T229, T230, and T231 are shown as black dashed lines on the map.

NOTE: A host tends each campground, including the overflow area. If you are planning to use only the trails and not camp, there is no charge. However, *inform the host of your intentions and ask where you should park*, especially if the trailhead is in a camping area such as the north end of T124.

DESCRIPTION: The purpose of T 229, 230, and 231 loop nature trails is to provide campers with an easy access to routes around Silver, Saddle, and Apache Campgrounds. Generally, the paths pass through forest with open understory, and usually within sight of the campground. All routes have numerous low interpretive signs that discuss various aspects of local and regional environments. The messages are often repeated among the three trail loops.

Staying on these paths may be difficult because they are sometimes obscure. The loop around Apache Campground is the most visible. Look for the low interpretive markers scattered along the paths to use as trail finders. If the campground is out of sight for a while, you probably have missed the trail! Unofficial paths interconnect the three campgrounds.

ACCESS: To reach these trails, begin in Cloudcroft at the intersection of US82 and NM130, and drive US82 east 1.3 miles to its junction with NM244. Turn left, and follow NM244 north 1.8 miles to the large entrance sign on the right for Silver, Saddle, and Apache Campgrounds. All trails are accessed from here and directions to trailheads are given in the order reached from the main campground entrance as follows: east end of T124, north end of T122, west end of T124, T229, south end of T122, T230, and T231.

For T 230, drive to the Saddle Campground entrance and turn right, stopping at the self-service pay station. T 230 begins nearby, behind the water fountain.
